III. **Old Business:**

Chippewa Road update: Quotes to provide sewer on Chippewa Road: Contractor totals \$3.3 million. WBRA totals: \$947,000. Project should take about 3 months to complete. Johnny Lynch needs to get a quote from Chase Engineering for a 537 Plan update.

IV. **New Business:**

- 6175 Rt. 405 Hwy for sale: Property between sewer plant and the milk barn is up for sale. The property owner contacted WBRA to see if there was an interest in purchasing the parcel of land prior to it going up for sale. The property owner is asking \$30,000 for the parcel. **Motion** to authorize Johnny Lynch to work with Solicitor regarding an offer amount made by Ed Feigles. Second by Teri Snyder. All were in favor. Motion passed.
- Mantis Innovation Electric Auction: This company would like to meet with WBRA reps to discuss an electric power auction. Johnny Lynch and John Karichner will speak with Mantis Innovations on Tuesday morning to discuss electric prices. WBRA is currently in a 2-year contract with IGS Energy.

V. **Director's report:**

- Finished one project in Hughesville. The water line project will begin May 13, 2024. Water meters are 1. halfway done in Hughesville.
- Still waiting on Point and Castanea Townships to give the "go ahead" for their project. 2.

- VI. Solicitor's Report: Attorney Shoch is working on a flow chart for all sheriff's sale rules and deadlines for Tara.

Ed Feigles addressed the board regarding discussions with Muncy Boro's Manager, Charley Hall and Lycoming County's Hazard Mitigation Coordinator, Kelsey Green to sell WBRA a FEMA buyout lot for a pump station. More information to come.
